If you live in a building, your dog may be unhappy if he has to stay indoors. You must take him for a walk every day. Your dog will need a box or a basket. You must make it as comfortable as you can and give him a blanket: dogs like to roll themselves in something warm.

And, of course, dogs eat a lot! All dogs must eat meat and vegetables. Never give them too much or too little. You'll learn to know how much is necessary after some time. Make sure there is always fresh water for them.

If you think this is not too much trouble, then you are ready to have a dog as a pet.
